Case Study – ParalympicsGB Potentials Camp, Bath 2010

Background

ParalympicsGB's Potentials Camp at the University of Bath offered a crucial opportunity to discover what it would be like in 'Games Mode' for potential competitors, coaches and headquarters staff.

Requirement

The brief received from ParalympicsGB was:

- Provide and implement a clean and efficient waste recycling service for the ParalympicsGB Potentials Camp.
- Provide receptacles bearing the ParalympicGB logo
- Keep the site clean and tidy throughout the stay of the potential competitors, coaches and headquarters staff.

Approach

MJ Church Event Waste Management's proposal to fulfil this brief was to:

Set up and transport:

- Set up event's logos on bins
- Waste stations
- Skips
- Food chute for kitchens to the ground floor containers
- Heras Fencing

During the event provide:

- Bin monitoring and servicing the site
- Mini waste stations for the indoor sports hall

After the event:

- Collection of all equipment and waste
- Final sweep and pick of the area

Results

The event took place between Sunday 24th August and Sunday 31st August and the results show:

- The area was left clean and tidy and the event coordinators were extremely happy with the service provided.
